

LISA M. ZILKER, New York City

Ms. Zilker is an artist living and working in NYC. She earned her BFA in Fine Arts and Art Education from the School of Visual Arts. She has shown in many solo and group exhibits, including a one person show at the National Arts Club in NYC. Her artwork falls into two categories: abstract expressionism and surrealism.

One of Zilker's important series, called Monuments, began as a sequence named Tombstones and has now evolved into what she calls Portals. In these works, the viewer is looking into or through an opening, glimpsing a hidden space where objects can be simplified botanical shapes. These portals are grouped in threes symbolizing Unity: The Trinity, Family, and Community.
